CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. This is an approved Coast & Valley Swimming Association and Swimming NSW qualifying meet and semi-electronic timing will be used for all timed finals.
- 2. Heats will be run fastest to slowest.
- 3. The meet will be conducted under Swimming NSW rules.
- 4. Competitor age will be determined as age on 9 January 2026.
- 5. Entries to be submitted online via Swim Central ONLY.
- 6. Entries close on **2 January 2026** and late entries will **NOT** be accepted. Entries may close earlier if entry/timeline limit is reached.
- 7. Entries will be \$8.00 per event.
- 8. Refunds will only be issued until **31 December 2025** for competitor withdrawals. No exceptions will be made to this condition.
- 9. Pool entry will be charged for all swimmers and spectators. **FREE** entry for all coaches.
- 10. Enquiries to the Club Race Secretary at nbay.racesec@gmail.com.

11. Medals & Prize Money:

- In the 12/U 50m events, medals will be awarded for the first three places in 8/U, 9 years, 10 years and 11-12 years.
- In the 12/U 100m events and Multi-Age 200m events, medals will be awarded for the first three places in 10/U and 11-12 years.
- In the 13/O and Multi-Age events, cash prizes will be awarded for the first three places in 13-14 years and 15+ years.
- In Open events, cash prizes will be awarded to the first three places, regardless of age.
- 12. Please note the following minimum ages:
 - 200m events 9 years old
 - 400m events − 11 years old
 - 800m/1500m 12 years old
- 13. Visiting clubs will be required to assist with time keeping. A lane roster will be issued for timing duties closer to the event and published on the Nelson Bay Swim Club Facebook page.
- 14. All unclaimed medals and prize money will be forfeited if not collected by the end of the carnival.
